as they work to meet their insurance deductible.

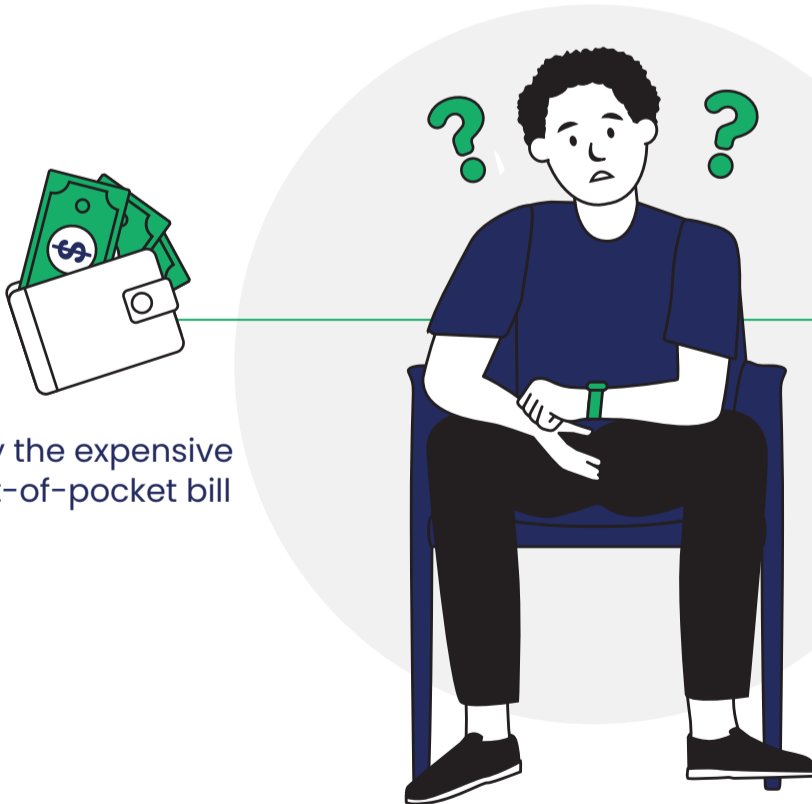
But some insurers impose co-pay accumulator programs.
