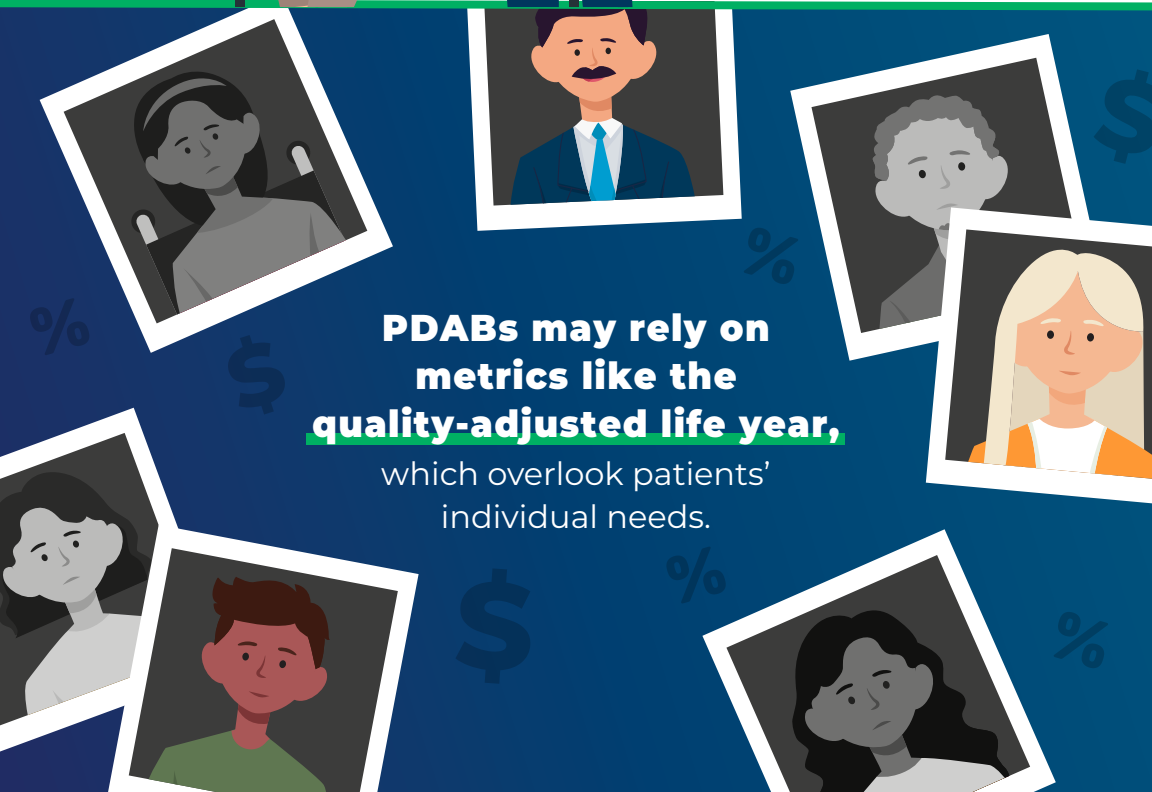
An Incomplete Way to View Medication Value



Prescription drug affordability boards, or PDABs, assess medication cost to decide what a state will pay.



PDABs usually take a narrow view of health care value, focusing on the state budget instead of patient experiences.



PDABs may rely on metrics like the quality-adjusted life year, which overlook patients' individual needs.

Value should encompass prices and patients.
