




Prescription drug affordability boards, or PDABs, are state-level boards that aim to lower medication spending for the state.

But they can cause problems for patients.

PDABs <u>limit</u> the state's payment for certain medications, unintentionally reducing treatment options for clinicians and patients.

Payment limits are <u>limiting</u> patient access.
