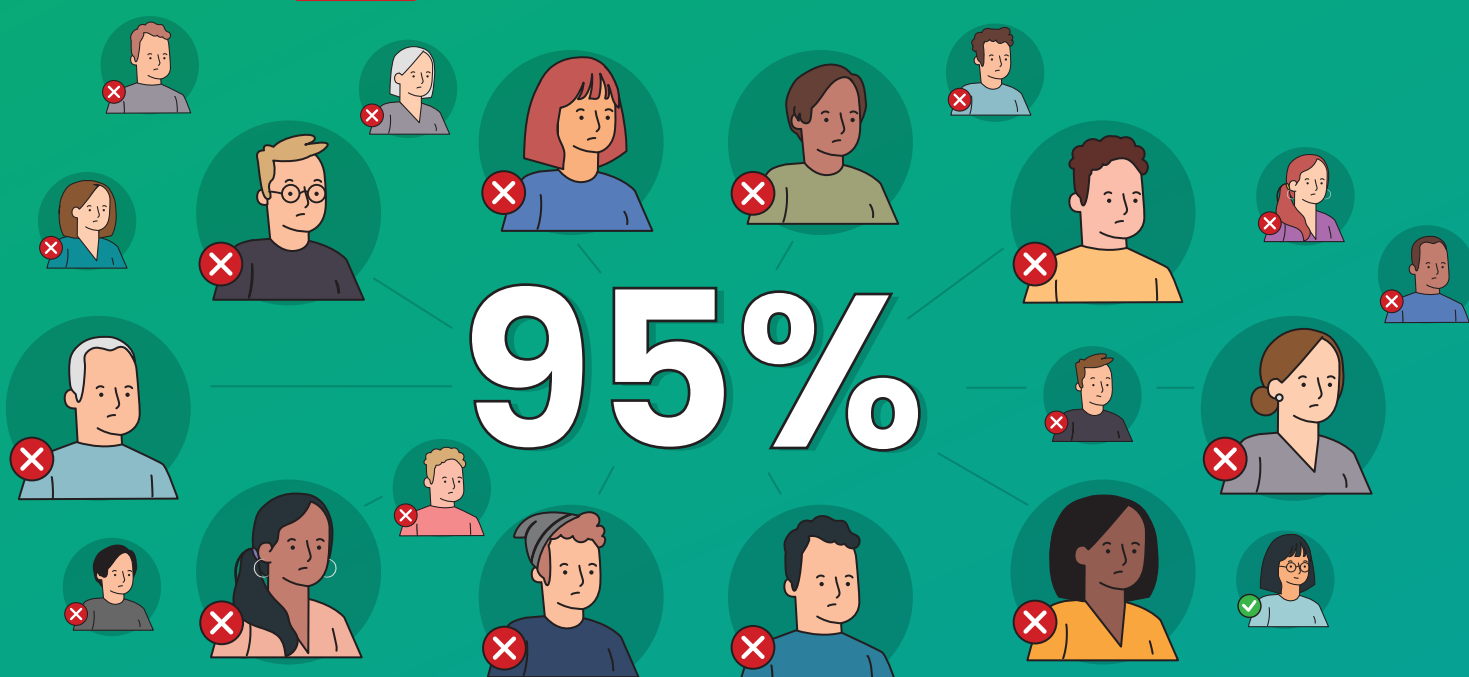


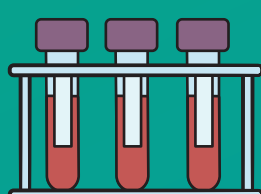
Reducing Access Barriers for Rare Disease Patients
